1. Create a Simulation Course Section



Login into your instructor panel > **create a new multiplayer simulation** game. Select the turn dates, and Voila! You now have a course section code that you can embed in your course outline. 2. Students Register

Students will register for your course section at MISsimulation.com.

Students get immediate access to a single player environment to familiarize themselves with the simulation game.

3. Students Participate

Students collaborate in groups to acquire and strategically use the simulation data. They improve the effectiveness of their operations, define strategy, and attempt to gain competitive edge against other student groups in the course.



4. Students Reflect on Lessons Learned¹
